

Incoming Telephone Calls





• Can the queue number not be reinstated? This would help patients have a rough idea how long the wait time is?


We understand that managing our call queue effectively is crucial and we are currently looking at systems that will help manage this. One system that we are exploring is a Triage system that will come equipped with tools and features that will help us streamline the queue, reducing wait times, and ensuring calls are prioritized based on urgency and clinical need. This system should also benefit our Team by providing a more efficient workflow. It will assist the staff in assisting patient needs more accurately and allocating resources appropriately. We will look at the possibility of reinstated the call queue.

Patients who Did Not Attend


